## About the Dayton Philharmonic Junior Strings

The Dayton Philharmonic Junior Strings was formed in 2014 in response to requests from string teachers and music educators for an orchestra that would encourage young string players not quite ready for the Dayton Philharmonic Youth Strings. From its inaugural season, the orchestra has grown from 31 to 45 string players from 28 area schools. The goal of this orchestra is to provide an opportunity for students to further develop their musical skills while learning to work together with other string players in an ensemble. Director Kara Camfield has been a member of the second violin section of the Dayton Philharmonic Orchestra since 2006. Ms. Camfield is also a member of the Dayton Philharmonic String Quartet, which presents in-school programs to primary-age students. She is an adjunct professor of violin at the University of Dayton and teaches privately.

## About the Dayton Philharmonic Youth String Strings

The Dayton Philharmonic Youth Strings was established in 1982 with the support of Mrs. Virginia Kettering, to provide musical enrichment and advanced concert experience for string students in grade 6-12. The ensemble is comprised of 65 students representing homeschools and 26 different schools from the greater Dayton area. Students in the Youth Strings will perform challenging original string literature. Regularly performing Winter and Fall concerts, DPYS often performs additional concerts throughout the year for senior centers and at community events. Director Dr. Betsey Hofeldt has been a member of the first violin section of the Dayton Philharmonic Orchestra since 1988. Dr. Hofeldt is a member of the Suzuki Association of the Americas and the American String Teachers Association.
